New Brunswick Soil and Crop Improvement Association (NBSCIA) is now accepting application for the On-Farm Climate Action Fund for the 2026-2027 crop year. The objective of the On-Farm Climate Action Fund is to support farmers in adopting beneficial management practices that store carbon and reduce greenhouse gases, specifically in the areas of:

1. nitrogen management
2. cover cropping
3. rotational grazing practices

Applications will be accepted from January 19, 2026 closing when funding is fully allocated, for projects funded in the current fiscal year ending March 31, 2027. Applications for funding will be considered on a "first-come-first-serve" basis.

Applicants must submit a complete application to be considered for funding. The application package consists of the application form and the corresponding Appendix A, B or C for each BMP (A. nitrogen management, B. cover cropping, C. rotational grazing), as well as any project details (such as supplier quotes and estimates) required for each BMP.
